DID YOU KNOW?

New South Wales Premier Gladys Berejiklian recently announced a new underground concourse for Sydney's Central station as part of the Government's plan to upgrade the precinct.

The concourse, called Central Walk, will link Chalmers Street to the existing platforms for heavy rail, and the new metro platforms.

The entire station will be renovated to include escalators to suburban platforms and shops.

Central station is the busiest in the country. More than 250,000 people use it every day, with that number expected to rise to 450,000 in the next two decades.
